Christ Our King

Today's Feast of Christ the King refocuses our attention on the Power of God and our response to it. In the Nicene Creed, we profess that God is omnipotent: "**I believe in one God, the Father Almighty.**" The Bible is filled with references to the LORD as the Almighty and All-powerful One.

But the power of God is more than brute force, being stronger than anything else. Jesus' response to Pilate's question reveals something more powerful than domination. Kings, especially in the time of Jesus, control everything—the army, the land, the wealth, the people's lives. Jesus responded to Pilate: "*You say I am a king. For this I was born and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice.*" The truth is powerful; that is why we profess the truth of our faith in the creed each Sunday saying, "**I believe in one God, the Father Almighty.**..." Jesus, who reveals the Truth about God, about the Kingdom of God, and about happiness for human beings, proclaims that he is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Jesus is the antidote to all that weighs down human beings. In liberating us from that, Jesus truly shows himself to be our King and King of all Creation.

Acknowledging, living, and sharing Jesus as the Truth is more incumbent upon Intentional Disciples than ever before. In an ever increasingly secular world in which many cast off reliance on God and claim to set up their own truths, the result is not increased happiness and fulfillment, but more misery and selfishness. The power of God's love and truth is what liberates us from the ancient curse of sin.

If we acknowledge the absolute power and truth of God, there can only be one response: **Obedience**. When we understand that the LORD's power is exercised most wondrously through our crucified and risen Savior, then one attitude must dominate all others: **Thankfulness**. If acclaiming Jesus Christ as our Lord and King is more than just words, then we submit ourselves to his kingship through obedience to God's will and express our gratitude by offering ourselves each day as a living sacrifice of thanksgiving to God by lives lived in conformity that will.

Stewardship is the concrete, practical way that we live with Christ as our King. A stewardship attitude acknowledges everything as a blessing from God—Time, Talent, Treasure, Faith—to be used well and shared, because they are not MINE, but gifts entrusted to me to build up God's kingdom and to serve our King.

Cristo Rey

Hoy, la Fiesta de Cristo Rey vuelve a enfocar nuestra atención en el Poder de Dios y nuestra respuesta a Él. En el Credo de Nicea, profesamos que Dios es omnipotente: "**Creo en un solo Dios, Padre Todopoderoso**". La Biblia está llena de referencias al SEÑOR como el Todopoderoso y Omnipotente.

Pero el poder de Dios es más que fuerza bruta, es más fuerte que cualquier otra cosa. La respuesta de Jesús a la pregunta de Pilato revela algo más poderoso que la dominación. Los reyes, especialmente en la época de Jesús, controlan todo: el ejército, la tierra, la riqueza, la vida de la gente. Jesús respondió a Pilato: "*Tú lo has dicho. Soy rey. Yo nací y vine al mundo para ser testigo de la verdad. Todo el que es de la verdad, escucha mi voz.*" La verdad es poderosa; por eso profesamos la verdad de nuestra fe en el credo cada domingo diciendo: "**Creo en un solo Dios, Padre Todopoderoso.**..." Jesús, que revela la Verdad sobre Dios, sobre el Reino de Dios y sobre la felicidad de los seres humanos, proclama que Él es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida. Jesús es el antídoto contra todo lo que agobia al ser humano. Al liberarnos de eso, Jesús se muestra verdaderamente como nuestro Rey y Rey de toda la Creación.

Reconocer, vivir y compartir a Jesús como la Verdad les incumbe más que nunca a los Discípulos Intencionales. En un mundo cada vez más secular en el que muchos abandonan la confianza en Dios y afirman establecer sus propias verdades, el resultado no es una mayor felicidad y satisfacción, sino más miseria y egoísmo. El poder del amor y la verdad de Dios es lo que nos libera de la antigua maldición del pecado.

Si reconocemos el poder absoluto y la verdad de Dios, solo puede haber una respuesta: **la Obediencia**. Cuando entendemos que el poder del Señor se ejerce de la manera más maravillosa a través de nuestro Salvador crucificado y resucitado, entonces una actitud debe dominar a todas las demás: **el Agradecimiento**. Si aclamar a Jesucristo como nuestro Señor y Rey es más que simples palabras, entonces nos sometemos a su realeza a través de la obediencia a la voluntad de Dios y expresamos nuestra gratitud ofreciéndonos cada día como un sacrificio vivo de acción de gracias a Dios por vidas vividas en conformidad a esa voluntad.

La Corresponsabilidad es la forma concreta y práctica en que vivimos con Cristo como nuestro Rey. Una actitud de la corresponsabilidad reconoce todo como una bendición de Dios: tiempo, talento, tesoro, fe, para ser usado bien y compartido, porque no son MÍ-OS, sino dones que se me han confiado para edificar el reino de Dios y servir a nuestro Rey. **P.
