Becoming a Beloved Disciple

On this First Sunday of Lent, the Gospel of Mark jumpstarts the Lenten process of ***Becoming a Beloved Disciple of the Lord***. We read, “*Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”*” As we hear this concise proclamation by Jesus, the risk is that we hear it primarily as a negative message, a scolding, or a reprimand. The same tendency can occur for many as they consider the beginning of another Lent, associating it with guilt, suffering, and a burden.

So let’s look more closely at what St. Mark is conveying to us so concisely. Jesus came and announced:

- ◆ **gospel of God**—We know that the word ‘*gospel*’ means ‘Good News,’ so Jesus has something very good for us and positive to proclaim;
- ◆ **Fulfillment**- This ‘Good News’ is that the time of fulfillment is at hand, the time for God to fulfill all the promises not only that he had made to his Chosen People, but for us as well. The People of Israel had been awaiting and eagerly longing for the ingathering of all the scattered tribes of Israel;
- ◆ **Kingdom of God** —this fulfillment is God’s work, not the work of mere human beings, which is always imperfect and flawed;
- ◆ **Believe in the gospel**—the Lord is inviting us to trust in this ‘Good News,’ even if it seems **too** good to be True.
- ◆ **Repent**—many connote this word to be negative, but that can only be if our pride interprets it. When we understand that it literally means turning back to God or turning more to God, AND that God permits this no matter what we have done, then repentance is a Great Gift of God, not a burden!

So the heart of Jesus’ message is GOOD, VERY GOOD, but there is cost; there is a demand—that we leave behind our waywardness and turn to live God’s way.

As I preached last weekend, three maladies of the spiritual life can hinder us from growing closer to the Blessed Trinity—Complacency, Ignorance, and/or Denial. May we hear in the Lord’s Jesus proclamation His Lenten invitation to discover his Amazing Love for each of us. With your Lenten practices of Prayer, Self-denial, and almsgiving, can you allow Jesus to love you more, so you can flourish as a Beloved Disciple of His?

Convertirse en un Discípulo Amado

En este primer domingo de Cuaresma, el Evangelio de Marcos impulsa el proceso cuaresmal de convertirse en un discípulo amado del Señor. Leemos: “*Jesús se fue a Galilea para predicar el Evangelio de Dios y decía: ‘Se ha cumplido el tiempo y el Reino de Dios ya está cerca. Arrepiéntanse y crean en el Evangelio’*”. Al escuchar esta concisa proclamación de Jesús, el riesgo es que lo escuchemos principalmente como un mensaje negativo, un regaño o una reprimenda. La misma tendencia puede ocurrirle a muchos al considerar el comienzo de otra Cuaresma, asociándola con culpa, sufrimiento y una carga.

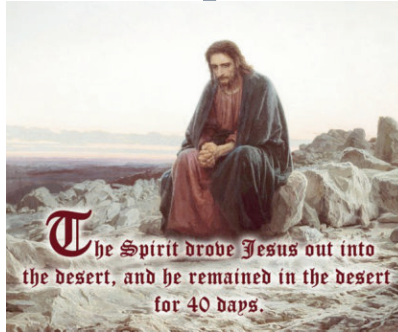
Así que miremos más de cerca lo que San Marcos nos transmite de manera tan concisa. Jesús vino y anunció:

- ◆ **evangelio de Dios**—Sabemos que la palabra “evangelio” significa “Buenas Noticias”, entonces Jesús tiene algo muy bueno para nosotros y positivo para proclamar;
- ◆ **Cumplimiento**- Esta ‘Buena Nueva’ es que el tiempo del cumplimiento está cerca, el tiempo para que Dios cumpla todas las promesas no solo que había hecho a su Pueblo Elegido, sino también a nosotros. El Pueblo de Israel había estado esperando y anhelando ansiosamente la reunión de todas las tribus dispersas de Israel;
- ◆ **Reino de Dios**: este cumplimiento es obra de Dios, no obra de simples seres humanos, que siempre es imperfecta y defectuosa;
- ◆ **Cree en el evangelio**: el Señor nos invita a confiar en esta “Buena Nueva”, incluso si parece **demasiado** buena para ser verdad.
- ◆ **Arrepiéntanse**: muchos connotan que esta palabra es negativa, pero eso sólo puede serlo si nuestro orgullo la interpreta. Cuando entendemos que literalmente significa volvernos a Dios o volvernos más a Dios, Y que Dios permite esto sin importar lo que hayamos hecho, entonces el arrepentimiento es un Gran Regalo de Dios, ¡no una carga!

Entonces, el corazón del mensaje de Jesús es BUENO, MUY BUENO, pero tiene un costo; hay una demanda: que dejemos atrás nuestro descarrío y nos volvamos a vivir a la manera de Dios.

Como prediqué el fin de semana pasado, tres enfermedades de la vida espiritual pueden impedirnos acercarnos más a la Santísima Trinidad: la complacencia, la ignorancia y/o la negación. Que podamos escuchar en la proclamación del Señor Jesús la invitación suya de la Cuaresma a descubrir su Amor asombroso por cada uno de nosotros. Con tus prácticas cuaresmales de oración, abnegación y limosna, ¿puedes permitir que Jesús te ame más para que puedas florecer como un discípulo amado suyo?

During Lent, Catholics are asked to devote ourselves to seeking the Lord in **prayer**, in reading Scripture, to service by **giving alms**, and to sacrifice through **fasting**. **Abstinence from meat is required** of Catholics ages 14 and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. In addition, **Fasting** is required of All Catholics ages 18-59 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day.

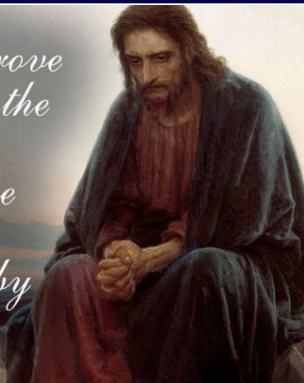

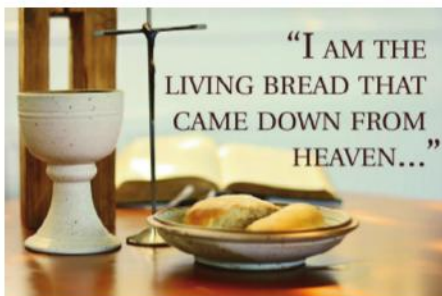
