Deformed by Sin; Transfigured by Grace

With Jesus' proclamation of last Sunday guiding us, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand," we can more readily embrace his exhortation this Lent to repent and believe in the Gospel. But it is not easy.

Trusting the Lord over ourselves may be logical, but it is certainly not easy. We see that with Abraham today. God commands Abraham to sacrifice his son, Isaac. Not only does Abraham love his son, Isaac, as any good father would, but sacrificing Isaac would seem to end the prospects of the LORD fulfilling his promise of making Abraham the father of many nations. After all, Isaac was his only son, his only hope for descendants.

To be Intentional Disciples of the LORD often requires us to sacrifice that which we cling to—our loves, our comforts, our fears. We don't want to let go of the things or persons we love or find comfortable, or we find it so difficult to trust God instead of uprooting our fears. Only when the words of St. Paul become real to us—"If God is for us, who can be against us?"—can we let go of all that we cling to, so as to grasp onto the LORD alone. This is the meaning of "**Repent and Believe in the Gospel!**"

Yet the 40 days of Lent do not comprise a self-help program or navel-gazing. The Transfiguration of the Lord on the Second Sunday of Lent refocuses our perspective that **Jesus Christ** is our hope. The goal of this battle with sin is not self-improvement or perfect compliance with all the rules and commandments. **The goal is a fuller relationship with the Lord Jesus;** the commandments and rules help us to do this.

On the mountain top, Saint Peter was overwhelmed and awed by this experience of the Transfiguration. Thus, he wanted to stay there with the Lord. Saint Peter was correct in exclaiming, "**Rabbi, it is good that we are here!**" But staying on the mountaintop was not Jesus' purpose. Through this powerful experience, the Father strengthened the disciples' faith in his Son and deepened their trust. This encounter with the LORD provided the future direction and encouragement that they needed: "**This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.**" This encounter with the LORD and their listening to him continued forming Peter, James and John as Intentional Disciples. Our regular encounters with the LORD and listening to him continue forming us as his Intentional Disciples.

Deformado por el pecado; Transfigurado por la gracia

Con la proclamación de Jesús del domingo pasado guiándonos: "*Este es el tiempo del cumplimiento. El reino de Dios está cerca*", podemos aceptar más fácilmente su exhortación en esta Cuaresma a arrepentirnos y creer en el Evangelio. Pero no es fácil.

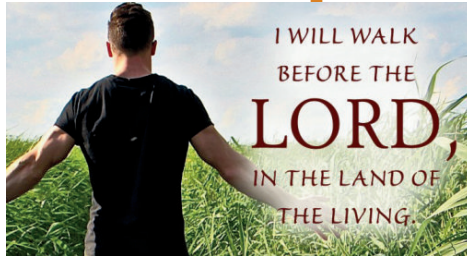
Confiar en el Señor sobre nosotros mismos puede ser lógico, pero ciertamente no es fácil. Vemos eso con Abraham hoy. Dios le ordena a Abraham que sacrifique a su hijo Isaac. Abraham no solo ama a su hijo Isaac, como lo haría cualquier buen padre, sino que sacrificar a Isaac parecería poner fin a las perspectivas de que el Señor cumpla su promesa de hacer de Abraham el padre de muchas naciones. Después de todo, Isaac era su único hijo, su única esperanza de tener descendientes.

Ser discípulos intencionales del Señor a menudo requiere que sacrifiquemos aquello a lo que nos aferramos: nuestros amores, nuestras comodidades, nuestros miedos. No queremos dejar ir las cosas o personas que amamos o nos sentimos cómodas, o nos resulta muy difícil confiar en Dios en lugar de desarraigar nuestros miedos. Sólo cuando las palabras de San Pablo se vuelven reales para nosotros: "*Si Dios es por nosotros, ¿quién contra nosotros?*" – podremos soltar todo aquello a lo que nos aferramos, para aferrarnos únicamente al Señor. Este es el significado de "**¡Arrepentíos y creed en el Evangelio!**"

Sin embargo, los 40 días de Cuaresma no comprenden un programa de autoayuda ni un mirarse el ombligo. La Transfiguración del Señor en el Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma reenfoca nuestra perspectiva de que **Jesucristo** es nuestra esperanza. El objetivo de esta batalla contra el pecado no es la superación personal ni el cumplimiento perfecto de todas las reglas y mandamientos. **La meta es una relación más plena con el Señor Jesús;** los mandamientos y reglas nos ayudan a hacer esto.

En la cima de la montaña, San Pedro quedó abrumado y asombrado por esta experiencia de la Transfiguración. Por eso quiso quedarse allí con el Señor. San Pedro tenía razón al exclamar: "**¡Rabí, qué bueno que estamos aquí!**" Pero permanecer en la cima de la montaña no era el propósito de Jesús. A través de esta poderosa experiencia, el Padre fortaleció la fe de los discípulos en su Hijo y profundizó su confianza. Este encuentro con el Señor les proporcionó la dirección futura y el aliento que necesitaban: "**Este es mi amado hijo. Escúchenlo.**" Este encuentro con el Señor y su escucha de él continuaron formando a Pedro, Santiago y Juan como Discípulos Intencionales. Nuestros encuentros regulares con el Señor y su escucha de él continúan formándonos como sus Discípulos Intencionales.

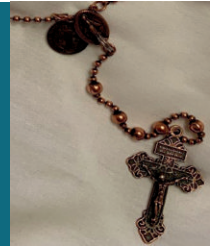

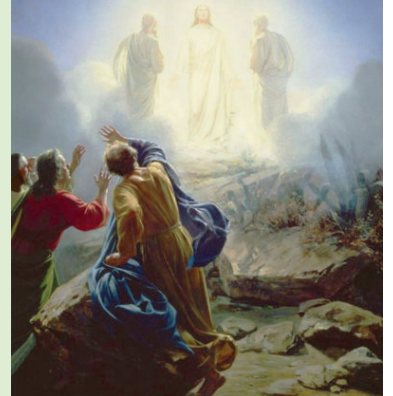
