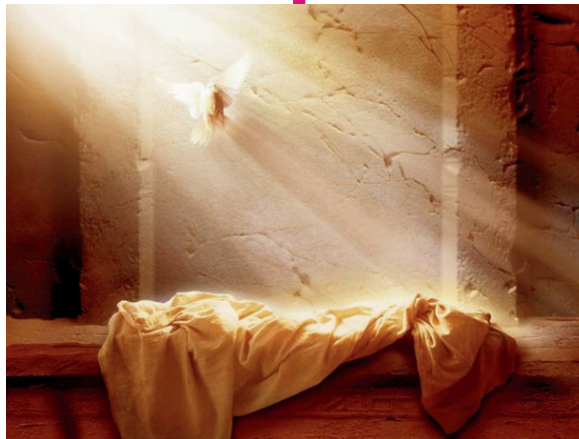

## ***You are Witnesses of these things!***

***Christ is Risen! Truly, He is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!***

The Scriptural witnesses to the Lord's Resurrection include the empty tomb, the angel, the revelation in the breaking of bread, the glorious wounds in his hands and feet, the Peace in the disciples' hearts, and their transformation as bold witnesses to the Risen Lord. These witnesses enable us to believe and trust in God's mighty work for us in Christ Crucified and Risen. This is the trust and belief expressed in the image of Divine Mercy, "***Jesus, I trust in You.***" Belief in Christ's resurrection enables us:

- ◆ to believe that Jesus is the one sent by God;
- ◆ to repent for the forgiveness of sins;
- ◆ to have eternal life in his Holy Name;
- ◆ to trust more and more that God's Divine Mercy is more powerful than everything; including our worst sins and death;
- ◆ to encounter him, even today, in the Eucharist, the breaking of bread, at Mass;
- ◆ to know the Peace and Joy of being God's beloved children.



The frightened disciples thought they were seeing a ghost when the Risen Lord appeared. The Lord replied, "*Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have.*" Christ's glorified body testified to the fact that he was alive and risen and that his body was an important part of his resurrected nature. After showing them his hands and feet, the Lord asked for some food to show that he was truly risen from the dead. These very physical acts emphasize the importance of our bodies as human beings. Consequently, we can appreciate more fully that our New Life as God's sons and daughters is nurtured and cultivated concretely and physically through the Paschal sacraments Christ has given us.

The more frequently and more profoundly we encounter the Risen Lord in his Word and through his Sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Confession, the more we will believe and trust. And the more we believe, the more we will embody in our own lives, hearts and relationships the power of God's love for others. That is what it means for us to be his 'witnesses of all these things.'

## ***¡Ustedes son testigos de estas cosas!***

***¡Cristo ha resucitado! ¡En verdad, ha resucitado!  
¡Aleluya! ¡Aleluya!***

Los testigos bíblicos de la Resurrección del Señor incluyen la tumba vacía, el ángel, la revelación al partir el pan, las gloriosas heridas en sus manos y pies, la paz en los corazones de los discípulos y su transformación como testigos audaces del Señor Resucitado. . Estos testigos nos permiten creer y confiar en la poderosa obra de Dios por nosotros en Cristo Crucificado y Resucitado. Ésta es la confianza y la creencia expresadas en la imagen de la Divina Misericordia: "***Jesús, en Ti confío***". Creer en la resurrección de Cristo nos permite:

- ◆ creer que Jesús es el enviado de Dios;
- ◆ arrepentirse para el perdón de los pecados;
- ◆ tener vida eterna en su Santo Nombre;
- ◆ confiar cada vez más en que la Divina Misericordia de Dios es más poderosa que todo; incluyendo nuestros peores pecados y la muerte;
- ◆ encontrarlo, también hoy, en la Eucaristía, en la fracción del pan, en la Misa;
- ◆ conocer la Paz y la Alegría de ser hijos amados de Dios.

Los discípulos asustados pensaron que estaban viendo un fantasma cuando apareció el Señor Resucitado. El Señor respondió: "*Tócame y verás, porque un fantasma no tiene carne ni huesos como puedes ver que yo tengo*". El cuerpo glorificado de Cristo testificó el hecho de que él estaba vivo y resucitado y que su cuerpo era una parte importante de su naturaleza resucitada. Después de mostrarles sus manos y pies, el Señor pidió algo de comida para demostrar que verdaderamente había resucitado de entre los muertos. Estos actos tan físicos enfatizan la importancia de nuestros cuerpos como seres humanos. En consecuencia, podemos apreciar más plenamente que nuestra Nueva Vida como hijos e hijas de Dios se nutre y cultiva concreta y físicamente a través de los sacramentos pascuales que Cristo nos ha dado.

Cuanto más frecuente y profundamente encontremos al Señor Resucitado en su Palabra y a través de sus Sacramentos, especialmente la Eucaristía y la Confesión, más crearemos y confiaremos. Y cuanto más creamos, más encarnaremos en nuestras propias vidas, corazones y relaciones el poder del amor de Dios por los demás. Eso es lo que significa para nosotros ser sus 'testigos de todas estas cosas.'

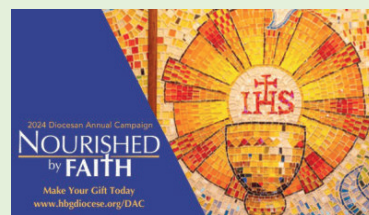

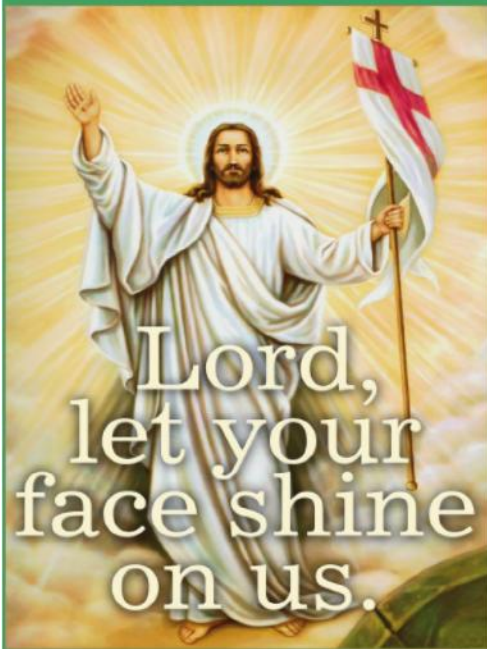
