


Pastor's Welcome



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Dear Fellow Parishioners,

On behalf of our Parish Pastoral Council and Finance Council, I am pleased to present our financial report for the 2020-2021 fiscal year, ending June 30, 2021.

Financially, this has been another extraordinary year of generosity, which is a testament to you, our faithful parishioners, and the commitments our families make to our Catholic community. Some of the giving highlights from this past year include:

- 50 MORE HOUSEHOLDS CONTRIBUTED FINANCIALLY
- ONLINE GIVING FOR THE SUNDAY COLLECTION HAS INCREASED BY 36% OVER THE PREVIOUS YEAR
- TOTAL NUMBER OF GIFTS ONLINE INCREASED BY 30%
- A BEQUEST FROM 1 GENEROUS
 PARISHIONER PROVIDED \$71,017 FOR THE
 PARISH & SCHOOL
- SCHOOL ENROLLMENT INCREASED BY 53 STUDENTS AND THE PARISH SUBSIDY TO SCHOOL WAS REDUCED BY \$346,800
